## What's New:

### UI & Usability Improvements

- **Patient Page Search Box** – Cursor now defaults to the search text box when entering the Patient page, saving time and improving workflow efficiency.

### Immunisation & Reporting Enhancements

- **Flu vaccines / NIPVIP inclusion for 2026** – The following vaccines are now available in the Immunisation and Flu Vaccination forms:
  - Flud
  - VaxiGrip
  - Flucelvax
- **Total vaccine count in Immunisation Summary Report (PDF)** – Added a clearer total vaccination count for improved reporting and understanding.
- **Flu Mist & route/site of administration options** – The vaccine FluMist has been added to the Flu and Immunisation forms. The value Nasal is listed in the route and site of administration fields.
- **Pre-population of vaccine data in COVID-19 form** – Now aligned with existing Immunisation and Flu form functionality, vaccine data will populate from the previous COVID-19 form to reduce manual entry.

### Workflow Improvements

- **Simplified UTI antibiotic treatment entry** – If an antibiotic is supplied to a patient, it can now be recorded in the form by directly selecting the antibiotic from a radio list, with no additional data entry required.

*Note: Pharmacists must continue to adhere to their applicable state protocol.*

Pharmacists must select the appropriate antibiotic according to their state protocol and patient assessment. \*

## Medadvisor App – Active Script List (ASL)

- Patients can now activate ASL even if their name differs between Medadvisor/dispense records and ASL.
- This mismatch will no longer block account activation, reducing setup issues for patients.

## General Enhancements

- **Admin of Injection guidance updated**

– Instructional text has been added to clearly direct pharmacists to record vaccinations in the applicable Immunisation form to ensure records are submitted to AIR and PPA. The Administration of Injection form should be used for medication injections excluding vaccines.



- **Consultation IDs added to Document History**

– Consultation IDs are now visible across all PPS forms and are accessible from both Document History and the Service Report. This allows for faster referencing and troubleshooting when resolving service issues or payment queries.
