What's New:

Medadvisor App – Active Script List (ASL)

- Patients can now activate ASL even if their name differs between Medadvisor/dispense records and ASL.
- This mismatch will no longer block account activation, reducing setup issues for patients.

Updated Booking Calendar Functionality

- Pharmacies can now send pre-screening forms for Custom Services linked to a vaccination service.
- Patients will automatically receive the pre-screening form when booking their appointment.

General Enhancements

- **Admin of Injection guidance updated**

– Instructional text has been added to clearly direct pharmacists to record vaccinations in the applicable Immunisation form to ensure records are submitted to AIR and PPA. The Administration of Injection form should be used for medication injections excluding vaccines.



- **Consultation IDs added to Document History**

– Consultation IDs are now visible across all PPS forms and are accessible from both Document History and the Service Report. This allows for faster referencing and troubleshooting when resolving service issues or payment queries.

- **Sign-up from PPS re-enabled**

– The Sign-up from PPS feature has been restored and is now available for use, making patient onboarding easier and more consistent.

General Enhancements cont.

- **Improved management of immunisation records**

– Vaccine records in the multi-entry immunisation form can now be deleted in any order, improving usability and efficiency when managing multiple entries.

- **Secure file attachments in Patient Consult messages**

– Uploaded files can now be attached to secure notifications and referrals sent from Patient Consult, enabling additional documents to be sent securely.
